

## COMPLINE – Prayers for the End of the Day

---

*The term Complin (Compline) is derived from the Latin word completorium, complement.  
The name compline was given to this particular Hour because compline is, as it were, the completion of  
all the Hours of the day: the close of the day.*

Take a moment of silence to gather the thoughts of the day.

### The Preparation

- V. The Lord Almighty grant us a peaceful night and a perfect end.  
R. **Amen.**  
V. Our help is in the Name of the Lord;  
R. **The maker of heaven and earth.**

### The Confession

- V. Let us confess our sins to God.  
All: **Almighty God, our heavenly Father:  
We have sinned against you,  
through our own fault,  
in thought, and word, and deed,  
and in what we have left undone.  
For the sake of your Son our Lord Jesus Christ,  
forgive us all our offenses;  
and grant that we may serve you  
in newness of life,  
to the glory of your Name. Amen.**  
V. May the Almighty God grant us forgiveness of all our sins,  
R. **And the grace and comfort of the Holy Spirit be with us. Amen.**

### The Invitatory

- V. O God, make speed to save us.  
R. **O Lord, make haste to help us.**  
V. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit:  
R. **as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.**

### The Psalm (choose one)

#### Psalm 4 *Cum invocarem*

- <sup>1</sup> Answer me when I call, O God, defender of my cause; \*  
you set me free when I am hard-pressed; have mercy on me and hear my prayer.
- <sup>2</sup> "You mortals, how long will you dishonor my glory; \*  
how long will you worship dumb idols and run after false gods?"
- <sup>3</sup> Know that the LORD does wonders for the faithful; \*  
when I call upon the LORD, he will hear me.
- <sup>4</sup> Tremble, then, and do not sin; \*  
speak to your heart in silence upon your bed.
- <sup>5</sup> Offer the appointed sacrifices \*  
and put your trust in the LORD.
- <sup>6</sup> Many are saying, "Oh, that we might see better times!" \*  
Lift up the light of your countenance upon us, O LORD.
- <sup>7</sup> You have put gladness in my heart, \*  
more than when grain and wine and oil increase.
- <sup>8</sup> I lie down in peace; at once I fall asleep; \*  
for only you, LORD, make me dwell in safety.

#### Psalm 31 *In te, Domine, speravi*

- <sup>1</sup> In you, O LORD, have I taken refuge; let me never be put to shame; \*  
deliver me in your righteousness.
- <sup>2</sup> Incline your ear to me; \*  
make haste to deliver me.
- <sup>3</sup> Be my strong rock, a castle to keep me safe, for you are my crag and my  
stronghold; \*  
for the sake of your Name, lead me and guide me.
- <sup>4</sup> Take me out of the net that they have secretly set for me, \*  
for you are my tower of strength.
- <sup>5</sup> Into your hands I commend my spirit, \*  
for you have redeemed me, O LORD, O God of truth.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit:  
as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.

**Psalm 91** *Qui habitat*

- <sup>1</sup> He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High, \*  
abides under the shadow of the Almighty.
- <sup>2</sup> He shall say to the LORD, "You are my refuge and my stronghold, \*  
my God in whom I put my trust."
- <sup>3</sup> He shall deliver you from the snare of the hunter \*  
and from the deadly pestilence.
- <sup>4</sup> He shall cover you with his pinions, and you shall find refuge under his wings; \*  
his faithfulness shall be a shield and buckler.
- <sup>5</sup> You shall not be afraid of any terror by night, \*  
nor of the arrow that flies by day;
- <sup>6</sup> Of the plague that stalks in the darkness, \*  
nor of the sickness that lays waste at mid-day.
- <sup>7</sup> A thousand shall fall at your side and ten thousand at your right hand, \*  
but it shall not come near you.
- <sup>8</sup> Your eyes have only to behold \*  
to see the reward of the wicked.
- <sup>9</sup> Because you have made the LORD your refuge, \*  
and the Most High your habitation,
- <sup>10</sup> There shall no evil happen to you, \*  
neither shall any plague come near your dwelling.
- <sup>11</sup> For he shall give his angels charge over you, \*  
to keep you in all your ways.
- <sup>12</sup> They shall bear you in their hands, \*  
lest you dash your foot against a stone.
- <sup>13</sup> You shall tread upon the lion and the adder; \*  
you shall trample the young lion and the serpent under your feet.
- <sup>14</sup> Because he is bound to me in love, therefore will I deliver him; \*  
I will protect him, because he knows my Name.

- <sup>15</sup> He shall call upon me, and I will answer him; \*  
I am with him in trouble, I will rescue him and bring him to honor.
- <sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him, \*  
and show him my salvation.

**Psalm 134** *Ecce nunc*

- <sup>1</sup> Behold now, bless the LORD, all you servants of the LORD, \*  
you that stand by night in the house of the LORD.
- <sup>2</sup> Lift up your hands in the holy place and bless the LORD; \*  
the LORD who made heaven and earth bless you out of Zion.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit:

**The Reading** (*choose one*)

Lord, you are in the midst of us, and we are called by your Name:  
Do not forsake us, O Lord our God. ~ *Jeremiah 14:9,22*

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. ~ *Matthew 11:28-30*

May the God of peace, who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, and great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in you that which is pleasing in his sight; through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. ~ *Hebrews 13:20-21*

*Or:*

Be present, O merciful God, and protect us through the hours of this night, so that we who are wearied by the changes and chances of this life may rest in your eternal changelessness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

*Or:*

Look down, O Lord, from your heavenly throne, and illumine this night with your celestial brightness; that by night as by day your people may glorify your holy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

*Or:*

Visit this place, O Lord, and drive far from it all snare of the enemy; let your holy angels dwell with us to preserve us in peace; and let your blessing be upon us always; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

*And:*

Loving creator of all, watch over us this night and keep up in the light of your presence. May our praise continually blend with the song of all creation, until we come to those eternal joys which you promise in your love; through Jesus Christ our Saviour. **Amen.**

*Or:*

God the source of eternal light, shed forth your unending day on us who watch for you; that our lips may praise you, our hearts bless you, and our lives glorify you; through our saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

*Or:*

Remember, merciful God, what you have made of us and not what we deserve; and as you have called us to your service, make us worthy of your calling; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

*Or:*

May our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God our Father, who loved us and graciously gave us unfailing encouragement and good hope, comfort our hearts and establish them in every good word and deed. **Amen.**

*Or:*

Living God, in you there is no darkness; shed upon us through this night the light of your forgiveness, your healing and your peace, that when we wake from sleep we may know once more the brightness of your presence; through our Saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

*Or:*

Gracious God, you have given us much today; grant us also a thankful spirit. Into your hands we commend ourselves and those we love. Be with us still, and when we take our rest, renew us for the service of your Son Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

*Or:*

We give thanks, O God, for revealing your Son Jesus Christ to us by the light of his resurrection: Grant that as we sing your glory at the close of this day, our joy may abound in the morning as we celebrate the Paschal mystery; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

## Further Prayers

Keep watch, dear Lord, with those who work, or watch, or weep this night, and give your angels charge over those who sleep. Tend the sick, Lord Christ; give rest to the weary, bless the dying, soothe the suffering, pity the afflicted, shield the joyous; and all for your love's sake. **Amen.**

*Or:*

O God, your unfailing providence sustains the world we live in and the life we live: Watch over those, both night and day, who work while others sleep, and grant that we may never forget that our common life depends upon each other's toil; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

## The Song of Simeon

V. Guide us waking, O Lord,  
R. **and guard us sleeping;**  
V. that awake we may watch with Christ,  
R. **and asleep we may rest in peace.**

**All: Lord, you now have set your servant free \***  
**to go in peace as you have promised;**  
**For these eyes of mine have seen the Savior, \***  
**whom you have prepared for all the world to see:**  
**A Light to enlighten the nations, \***  
**and the glory of your people Israel.**

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: \*  
as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.

V. Guide us waking, O Lord,  
R. **and guard us sleeping;**  
V. that awake we may watch with Christ,  
R. **and asleep we may rest in peace.**
